## BLACK LIVES MATTER


- Following George Zimmerman's acquittal on July 2013, activist and writer Alicia Garza wrote on Facebook: "Black people. I love you. I love us. Our lives matter, Black Lives Matter."
- Black Lives Matter is a phrase and an ideology in a world where black people systematically do not matter. We are absolutely shifting what is, what could be. And so Black Lives Matter is about a consciousness of a people – black folks first and foremost, because 'black lives matter' was about an affirmation of our own dignity, of our own lives. And then beyond that, it was a demand to the greater public, to the mainstream, to those who are in power who are maintaining the status quo."



Trayvon Martin died on February 26th, 2012
reminding Alicia Garza of her younger
brother whom she realized could have
easily been him. She also knew law
enforcement and the criminal justice system
was not going to address this issue. She
believes it is unacceptable for unarmed
black young men to be killed without
consequence. THAT is why
#BlackLivesMatter - to discuss why black
lives are undervalued.

Yes. However, racism and police brutality are major issues in the black community. The purpose is to spotlight us to raise awareness.



#### Blacks are more like to be killed by police

We live in a society in which black lives are systematically oppressed, survive off low wages, incarcerated, underemployed or unemployed. But most importantly, blacks live in a society where police encounters often turn deadly, usually without repercussions.
