Prepare a PowerPoint presentation based on a topic, article or person found in YES! Magazine #65.

Each presentation must contain the following elements/at least one slide per element:

- (1) Your name, cycle #
- (2) Summarize the main point of the article, person or program you are interested in from the magazine
- (3) What are they fighting for or what is the issue one sentence PLUS at least two images that illustrate the problem
- (4) At least two charts or graphs that show the trend/data dramatizing the gravity and scope of the issue being discussed
- (5) Your solution what should be done to solve/cure or stop the problem or lift up people so as to make the issue go away? Pretend you are going to solve this problem in Chicago. Please add images to bring your ideas to life this can take a few slides to make it clear what you want to do.
