Many don't have a basic understanding of budgeting, investing, borrowing, taxation, and personal financial management.

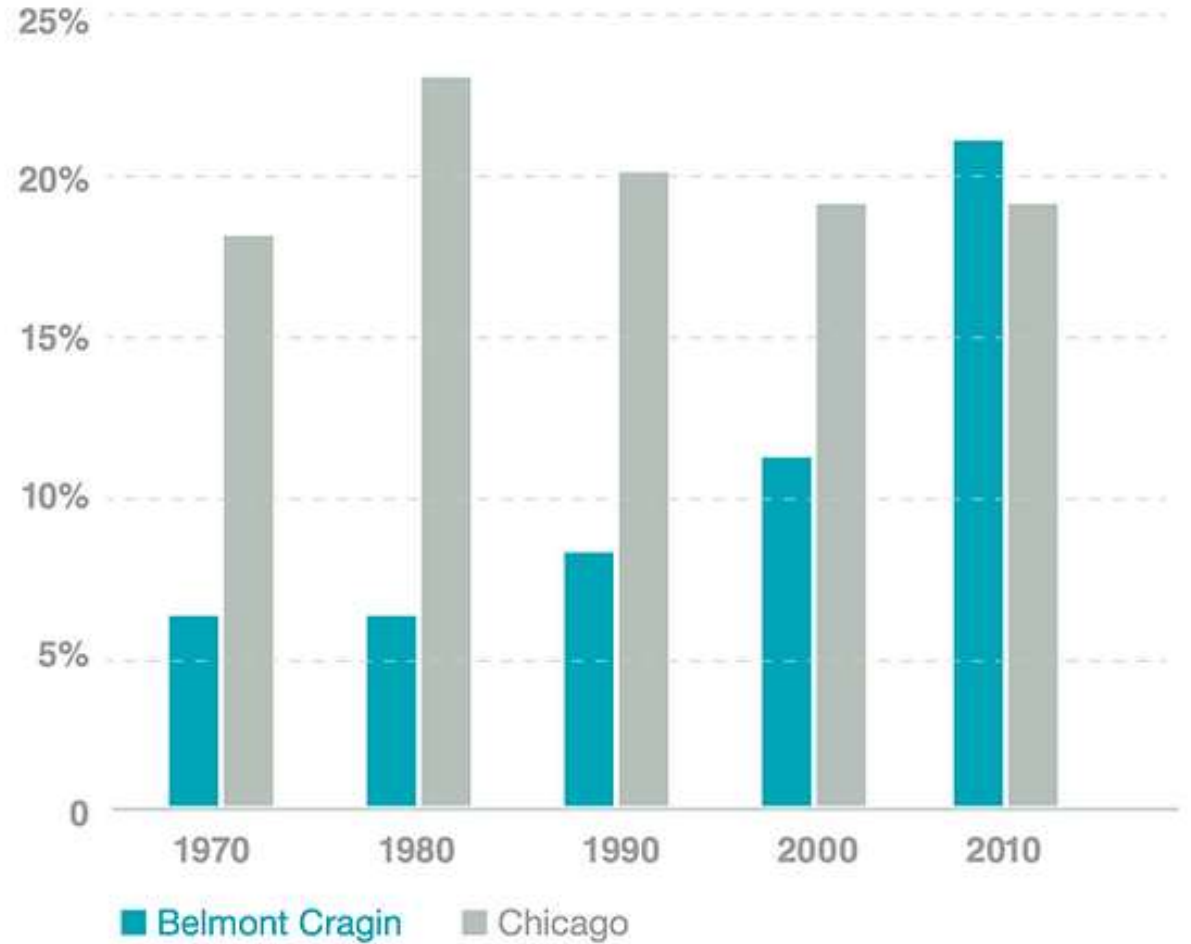

Population in Poverty



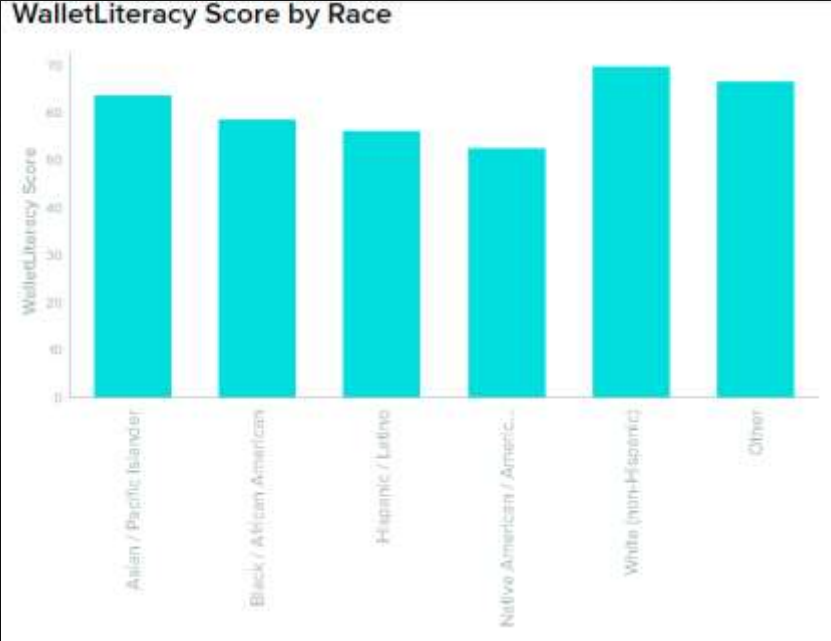
