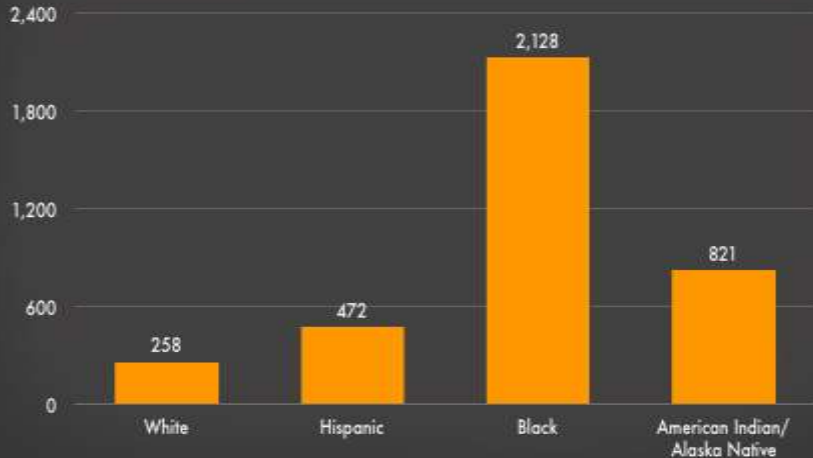

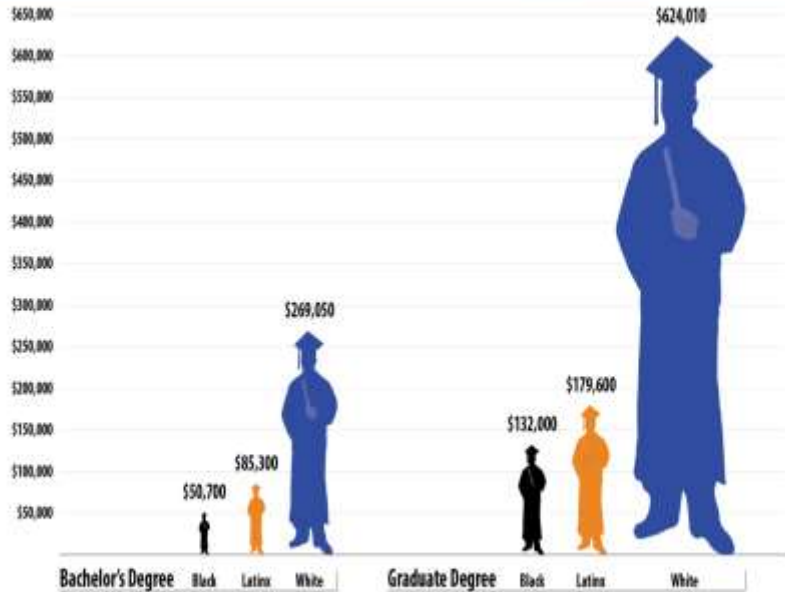

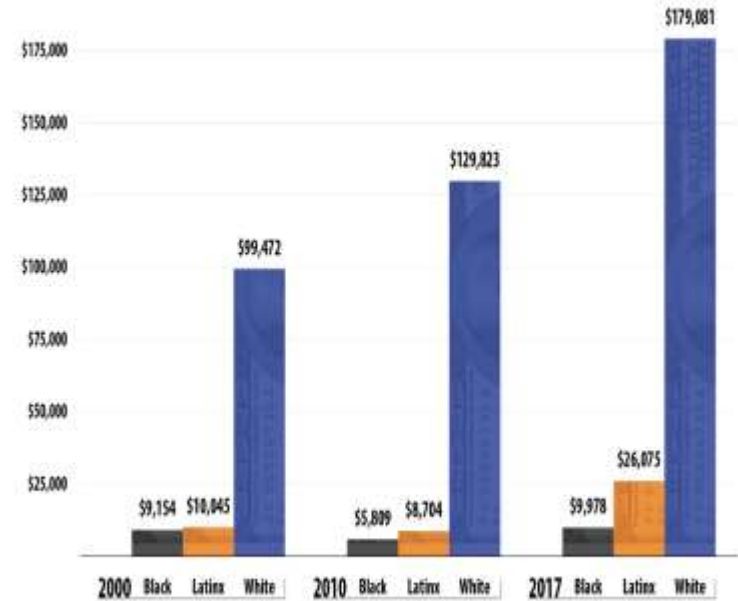
Median Net Worth of U.S. Households by Race and Academic Degree, 2019

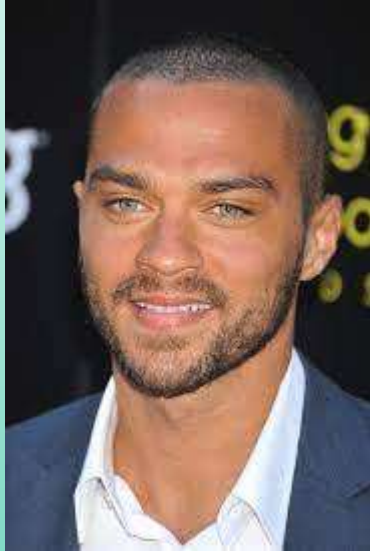
