

THE ISSUE


- Chicago has long been known as a racially segregated city.

Economic hardship index shows stark inequality across Chicago




Chicago, where tensions are running high following the release of the video showing the killing of Laquan McDonald, is the most segregated major metropolitan area in the U.S.:




THE DATA

Half of Chicago's census tracts were considered middle income in 1970. Today, that's down to 16 percent.


Much of Chicago neighborhoods includes those of the lowest income brackets.






