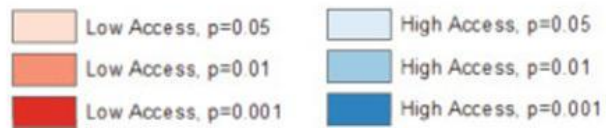
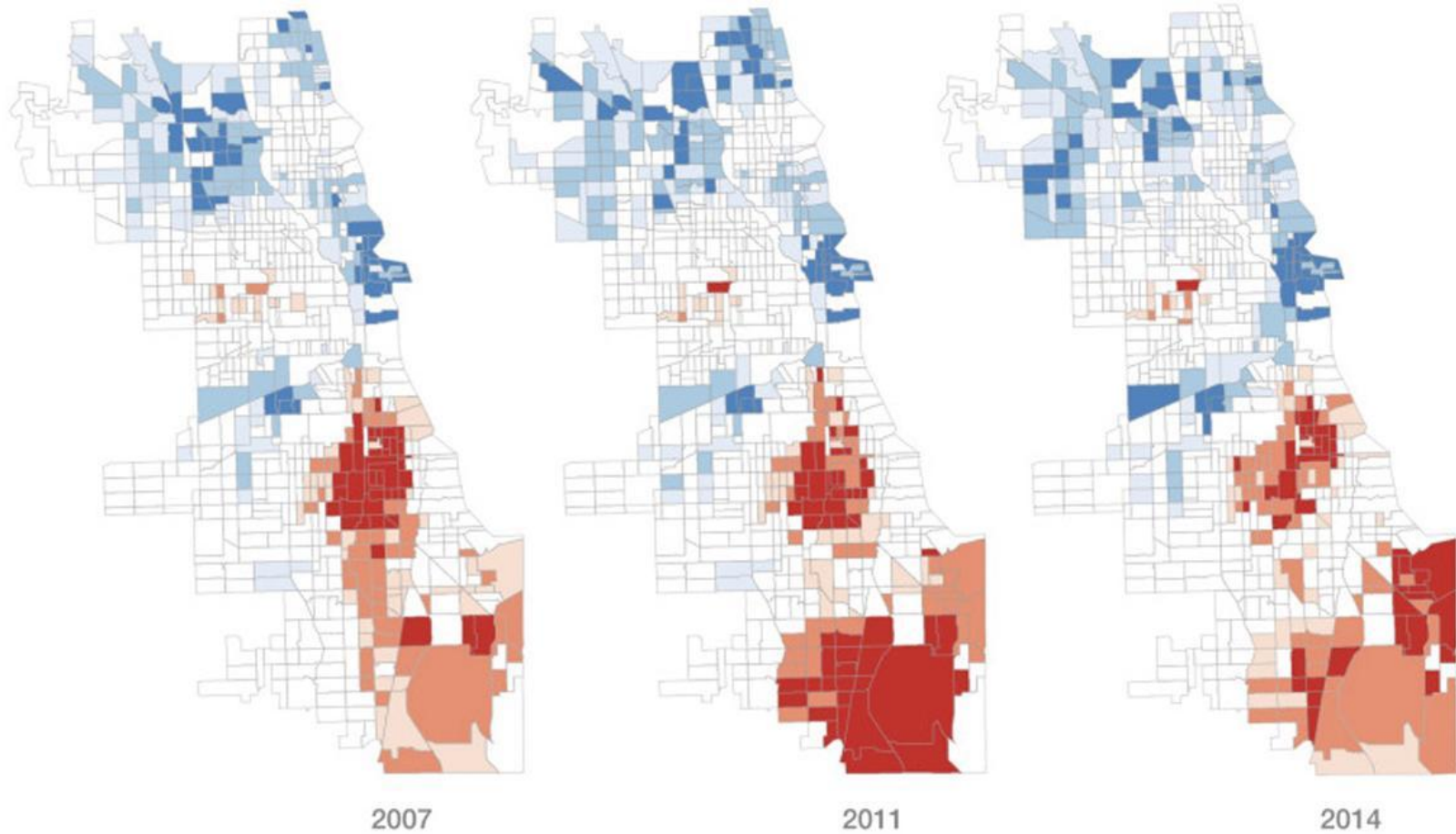

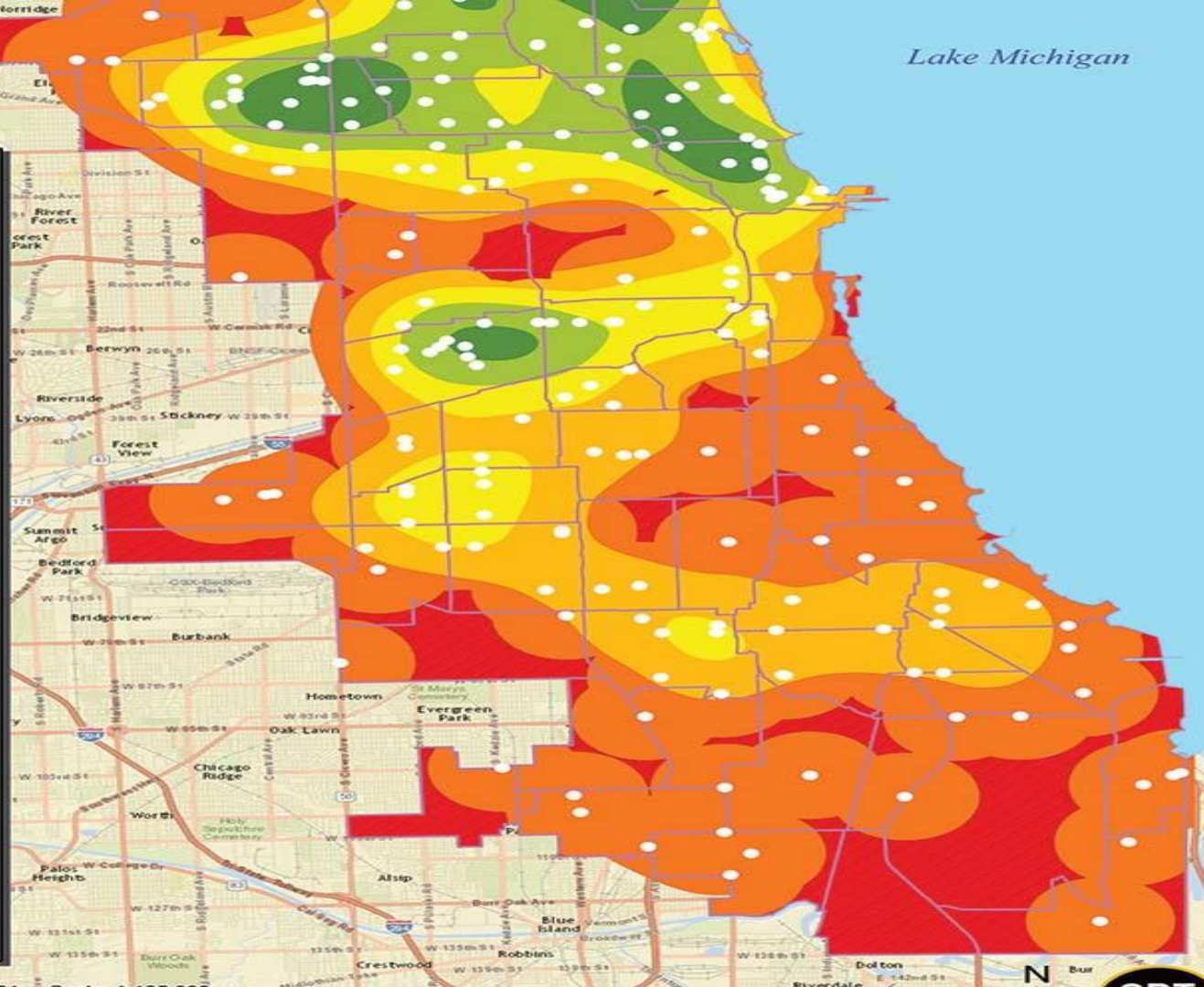
Food Accessibility

With over 240 grocery stores in the city, Chicago seemingly has many locations to purchase groceries. However, the distribution of these stores is not equal, with South and West Side residents having the poorest accessibility to quality food. Many of these residents are in fact located in food deserts, which The City of Chicago defines as areas located more than a mile from a retail food establishment larger than 10,000 square feet.

Grocery Store Accessibility Index

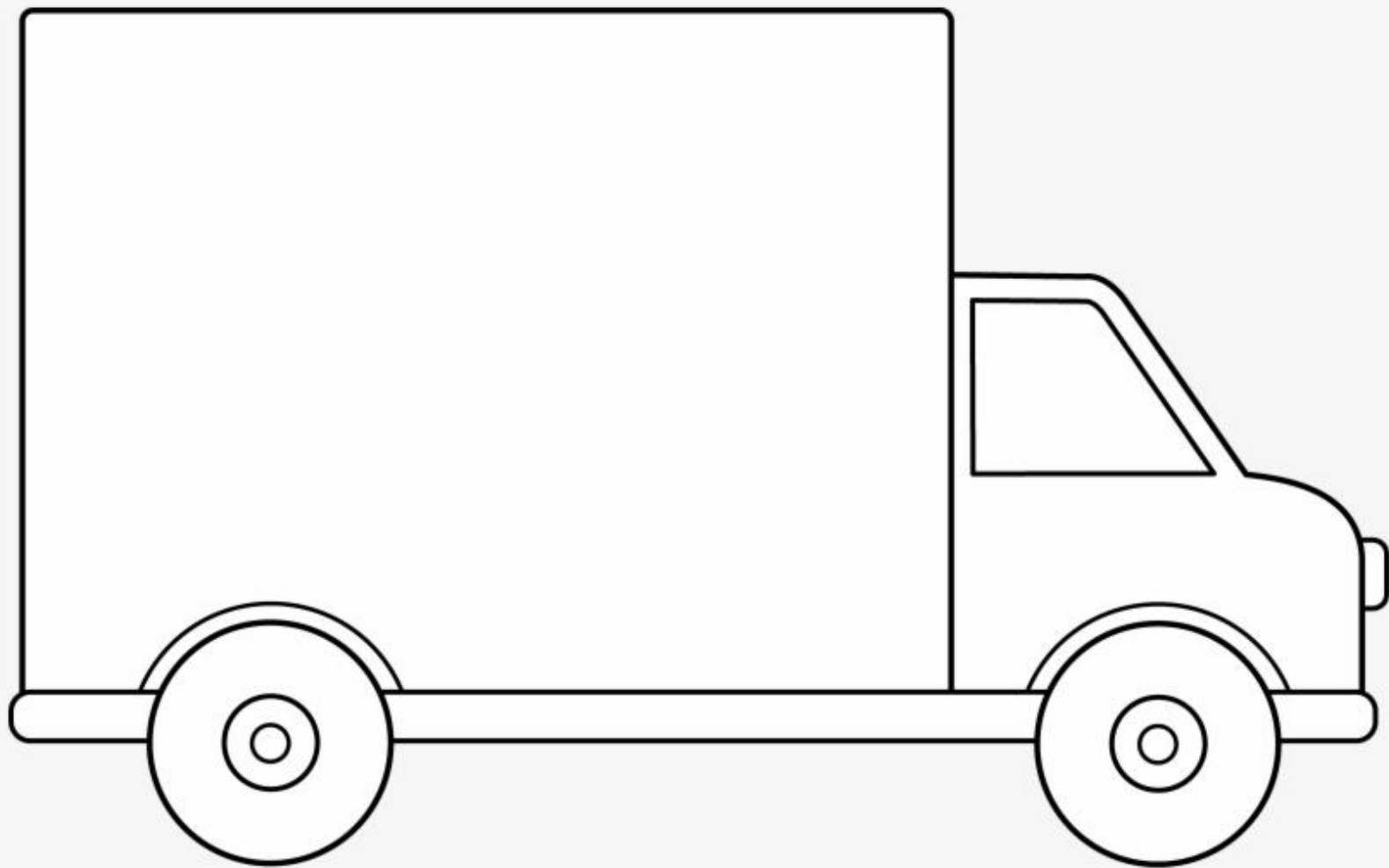

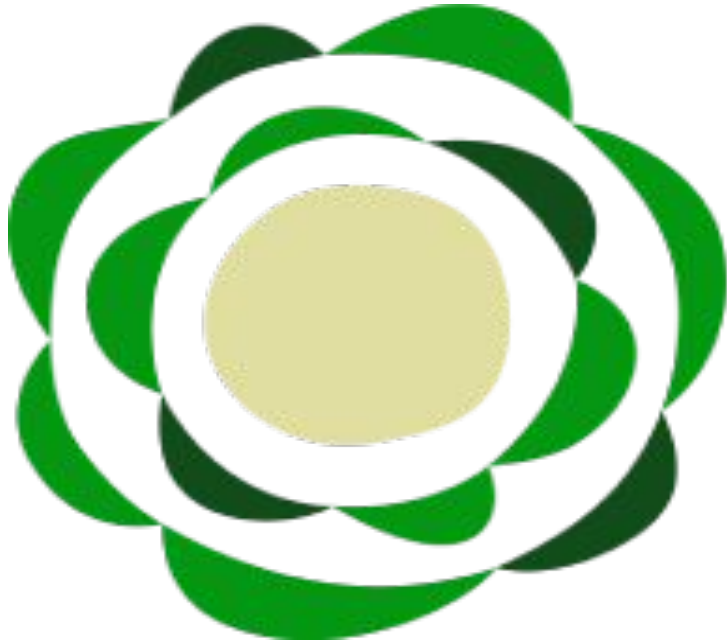






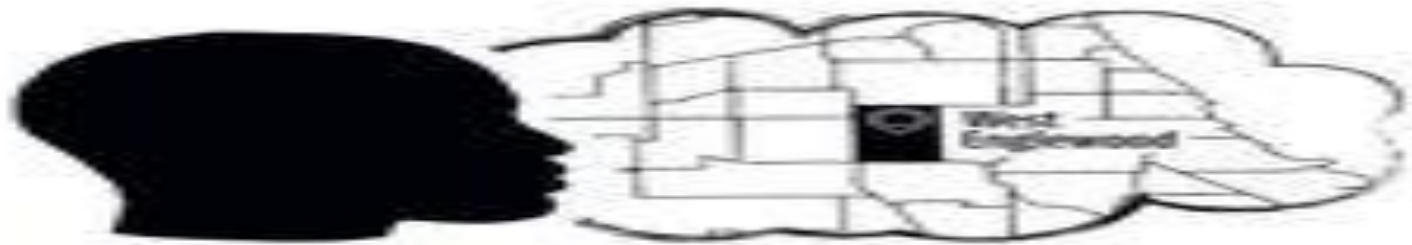
