













View 20 most dangerous community areas of 2021





IN CHICAGO, THE INCREASE IN MURDERS FROM 2019 TO 2020 WAS 55%, ACCORDING TO CPD HOMICIDE DATA, THOUGH LAST YEAR'S 3% INCREASE OVER 2020 TRAILED THE NATIONAL INCREASE OF NEARLY 7%




