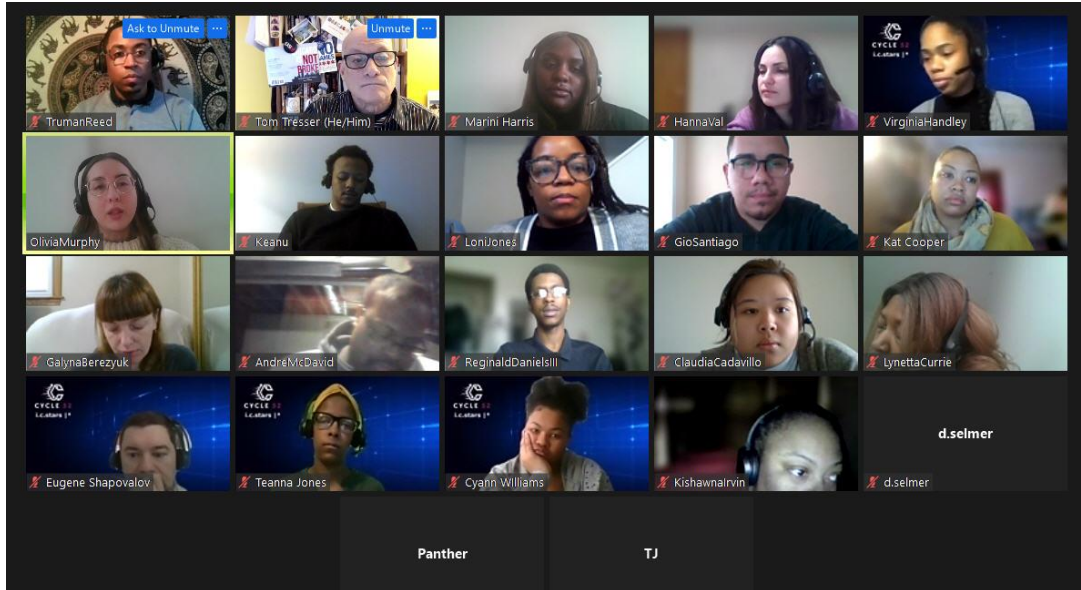



- Love before all.
- Love is powerful.
- Empathy = understand the other person
- Determined - persistent - willing to sacrifice
- Being generous - being willing to give up something...
- Step outside your self
- Perspective - balance
- Investment not "sacrifice"
